On Sunday, 17 September, basketball players, both girls and boys, from over a dozen schools met in our sports hall to take part in the annual ACS Cup basketball tournament. In the Boys' division, the ACS team succeeded in winning all three of their preliminary matches. The semi-final, against Yadika, was

closely contested but the result was 16 – 11 in favour of ACS. ACS had two teams in the Girls' division, one consisting of junior players and the other of senior players. Both teams played well in the preliminaries, with the Senior Girls' team winning all three of their matches, and the Junior Girls' team winning two. This resulted in an 'ACS versus ACS' semi-final, which the Senior team won. However, the Junior

girls must be commended on their determination, despite having to go up against their more experienced team-mates. Then it was time for the Finals. The ACS boys' team fought hard against SWA, resulting in a 30 – 12 win. Similarly, the girls' team also put in an excellent performance, beating SMA 5 by 8 points to 1. It was wonderful to celebrate an ACS victory in both the boys' and the girls'

teams. These results are proof of the effort and determination put in by our players and coaches. Thanks must also go to Mr Nadzi and his team for planning and co-ordinating the tournament, and of course, thanks to all of the parents who came to support their sons and daughters and cheer on our teams.

School Clinic (SOP)

School regulations regarding students with contagious diseases

- If a student shows symptoms of HFMD or other contagious diseases, the school nurse is to inform the Kepala Sekolah, VP and parents by phone and suggest he or she be sent home.
- The school nurse will recommend that parents take their child to a doctor and ask for a doctor's letter for confirmation.
- Children who are unwell should be kept off school for one week and/or until they are cleared to return by a doctor.
- The school nurse will coordinate with the cleaning department (CMA) to disinfect the classroom.

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
