

# Visual Arts 6 – 2016-2017

**Course Objectives:**

The students will develop an understanding of making large and small-scale artwork by exploring and experimenting with materials, images and ideas for 3D work. They will develop specific skills for recording using a variety of media. Students will respond critically to a variety of artwork, connecting the individual work to other works and to other aspects of human endeavor and thought.

**Main Topics Covered:****First Quarter**

- Use art materials and tools in a safe and responsible manner
- Recognize types of lines in optical art
- Understand perspective drawing
- Developing shape into form

**Second Quarter**

- Recognize and apply different textures
- Explore production techniques using different media
- Produce clay techniques

**Third Quarter**

- Explore different watercolour painting techniques
- Painting technique on canvas
- Analyse and make presentation based on their artwork

**Fourth Quarter**

- Create self-portrait combining the power of image and text
- Printmaking technique
