Course Objectives:

Art is an important part of early childhood education. The study of Art begins in Kindergarten with the introduction of skills and concepts that will be completely new for most of the students. It will emphasize joyful exploration and discovery. The students will become visually literate and expressive at a level consistent with their intellectual, emotional and physical development.

Main Topics Covered:

First Quarter

- Use tools safely and appropriately
- Become familiar with basic art skills and media
- Personal experience and/or imagination as a source of ideas
- Create artwork involving the usage of their five senses

Second Quarter

- Develop fine and gross motor skills
- Develop skills necessary for understanding and applying media and techniques
- Create 2D and 3D artwork

Third Quarter

- Use a variety of geometric shapes in artwork
- Understanding of pattern
- Create visual textures with basic art skills

Fourth Quarter

- Telling and recording well-known stories through art
- Use art skills to produce problem-solving games
