Subject Overview and Objectives

Communication is becoming an increasing part of the school environment, whether it is to perform in a school production, share an experience with peers during Show and Tell or communicate feelings or ideas to others. To give students the confidence to become confident communicators, Speech and Communication offers students a chance to study how to communicate more effectively.

This subject takes an in-depth look at the skills that effective communicators must possess and how communication can be used to shape the environment in which they live in: politics, culture and society. Lessons are designed to enhance verbal and non-verbal communication as well as develop techniques to inform, persuade or debate.

Students will analyze and critique print and non-print materials and embark on varied modes of independent and collaborative projects throughout the year.
