

Indonesian A: Language & Literature (HL/SL) 12 (2016-2017)

Time: 7x 35 minutes per week

Course Description:

The IB Indonesian A: Language and Literature in grade 12 focuses on text from Part 2 (language and mass communication) and Part 3 (literature-text and context) of the IB Curriculum. This course aims to develop in students ability to understand and analyze how texts, both literary and non-literary work to communicate to audience. Literary theory is discussed simultaneously during the study of texts in preparation for students' oral commentaries and the Examination Essays (Paper 1 and Paper 2).
