

Indonesian B (HL/SL) 12 (2016-2017)

Time: 7 x 35 minutes per week

Course Description:

Indonesian B focuses on language acquisition and intercultural understanding. The course is available at both higher level (HL) and standard level (SL). The two levels differ in the depth of syllabus coverage, the study of literature at HL and the level of difficulty and demands of assessment and assessment criteria. The syllabus content is divided into two main sections, the Core and the Options. In grade 12, students also have to finalize their Written Assignments. This assignment requires personal writing on the development of ideas and the transformation of personal response in to a formal essay.
