Main Topics Covered:

Semester 1:

First Quarter

Underlying concepts:

- Develop their Arabic letters with the harakat (fathah, kasrah and dammah)
- Explore the asmaul husna (ar rahman, ar rahim, al ahad, al malik and as samad) by making poster

Second Quarter

Underlying concepts:

- Recite the dua before and after making wudhu
- Recite the dua entering and leaving the bathroom
- Narrate the very basic story of prophet Muhammad

Semester 2:

Third Quarter

Underlying concepts:

- Recite the statement of intentions for five daily prayers
- Recite the dua iftitah, rukuk and sujud

Fourth Quarter

Underlying concepts:

- Conduct of shalat
- Respect to our teachers and neighbours
- Explore the asmaul husna (al gafur, al wahhab, al adlu, al alim and al hakim) by making short explanation in A3 paper
