
Main Topics Covered:

Semester 1

- Making an interview, a report, a statement of agreeing/disagreeing, an invitation, a simple dialogue, a formal letter, a narrative composition
- Understanding literature texts (identifying) and finding main ideas
- Reading and responding to various text formats (invitations, dialogues, poems, stories)
- Listening to dialogues, interviews and stories
- Conducting an interview
- Synonyms and antonyms
- The use of sentences to show hopes
- Suffixes (*di-i, di-kan, me-i, me-kan, ber-*)
- The use of numerical system (Roman numbers, the use of *ke-* with numbers)
- The use of semi colons (:) and quotation marks (“...”)
- Preposition (*pada, sejak, selama, sepanjang, menjelang, dengan, karena*)
- Introduction to proverbs (*peribahasa*) and idioms (*ungkapan*)
- Vocabulary connected to the topics ('Perayaan', 'Dunia Hiburan', 'Persahabatan')

Semester 2

- Making a simple comments on a factual matters, a summary and a conclusion of a short story, and a descriptive composition
- Listening to news and stories
- Understanding and comparing two reading texts of the same theme
- Scan various types of texts: a telephone book, a train/plane schedule, a program, a menu, etc.
- Making and presenting dialogues, making proper oral questions based on a text
- Positive and negative statements
- The use of *kata sandang* (*para, sang, sri, si*)
- Denotation and connotation meanings
- The use of pronouns
- The use of italics in sentences
- Suffixes (*ber-an, ber-kan, se-*), the function of a comma (,) and brackets ((...))
- Vocabulary connected to the topics ('Teknologi', 'Kehidupan di Laut', 'Kebudayaan')
