

Indonesian (Standard/Advanced) 8

Time: 5 x 35 minutes per week

Course Description:

The Indonesian language course in grade 8 aims to develop students' skills in reading, writing, speaking, listening and viewing. This is achieved by reading and viewing a range of texts and by writing with clarity and accuracy for a range of purposes and audiences. The course is divided into Indonesian Advanced and Standard based on the number, genre and complexity of the assigned texts and tasks. Indonesian (Advanced) students must write with a higher level of sophistication than those students in Indonesian (Standard).
