Code of Conduct

(adapted from FIFA Grassroots 2015)

1. Remember that children pay for fun. Help your child to enjoy the game regardless of the result.
2. Support your child by attending games and practice sessions.
3. Never criticize your child for making mistakes and avoid over-analyzing your child's performance after every game.



Code of Conduct

4. Applaud and encourage all players, including the opponents
5. Remain outside the field of play.
6. Respect the match officials' decisions.
7. Never use abusive language or behaviour.
8. Allow the coaches to do their jobs and do not confuse the children by interfering.



Code of Conduct

9. Encourage your child to speak directly to the coach if he is having difficulties. Taking responsibility like this is a big part of becoming a mature person.
10. Be responsible – help your child get to practice sessions and games on time.
11. Enjoy watching your child play football!
